SNAPSNOP! 2011 is a four-day series of photography workshops for high school students in the Los Angeles Area. SNAPSHOT! is a four-Saturday program that targets talented but at-risk High School students and provides a very hands-on, unique Photography Workshop experience that culminates in the exhibition of their work. This program is offered to 60 students across Los Angeles County who show an exceptional talent but who may not have the resources to study in extra-curricular workshops. SNAPSHOT! takes place during the Month of Photography Los Angeles (MOPLA), both are organized by The Lucie Foundation, a 501(c) 3 Charitable Foundation.
